ORDER RE USE OF STIPULATION FORMS

Except as provided herein, any Stipulation Re Facts, Conclusions of Law, and Disposition

or Alternative Discipline Program (ADP) Stipulation Re Facts and Conclusions of Law submitted

to the State Bar Court for approval after August 23, 2024, must use the stipulation forms, available

on the State Bar Court website at http://www.statebarcourt.ca.gov/Forms, on August 16, 2024.

These forms were revised to update probation and reproval conditions, to improve clarity, and to

be easier for the parties to use.

The Court will accept fully executed stipulations using the most recent prior versions of

the forms until November 1, 2024, without further order of the Court for cases in which a party

has prepared and submitted to the opposing party a proposed Stipulation Re Facts, Conclusions of

Law, and Disposition or proposed ADP Stipulation Re Facts and Conclusions of Law on or before

August 23, 2024.

Any party seeking to submit a stipulation that does not comply with this order, must file a

motion in advance that is supported by a stipulation signed by all parties and shows good cause

why the August 16, 2024, forms were not utilized.

This Hearing Department General Order supersedes Hearing Department General Order

23-02.
