## **NOTICE TO ALL PARTIES**

The State Bar Court Executive Committee has approved new and amended Rules of Practice of the State Bar Court (Rules of Practice) which will become effective June 3, 2024. The Rules of Practice have been amended to change some of the rules that will govern the voluntary use of electronic filing ("eFiling") in the State Bar Court when the eFiling system is launched. Specifically, the revised rules will require parties using the court's eFiling system to serve documents to file proof of service. In addition, some new types of documents have been added to the list of documents that cannot be eFiled under rule 1139.

To allow parties to understand the changes before they take effect, the revised Rules of Practice with the new and amended rules have been made available on the State Bar Court's website. The revised Rules are not available in printed form at this time.

The Rules of Practice are adopted by the Executive Committee to facilitate proceedings conducted in the State Bar Court. (Bus. & Prof. Code, §6086.5; Rules Proc. Of State Bar, rule 1010.)
